The total expenditure was much greater than the income. explained that the committee was trying to spend money to reduce the large surplus in the branch funds. One of the ways we were doing this was to give grants to towers having maintenance work carried out and by paying for maintenance inspections for towers. This is still open and if towers are interested they should apply.

asked if there was a level that we regarded as the minimum we would want to keep in the branch accounts - the running costs of the branch are less than the grant we get from the YACR each year, so there isn't really a minimum.

- b. Secretary's report circulated at this meeting and is as will be printed in the annual report unless there are any alterations today. said that she wanted to emphasise that grants are not only available for maintenance, but could be for anything that could benefit ringing within the branch. Also, we have purchased two DVD's from the Whiting Society - 'From Rounds to Ropesight' and 'Come on! Listen to it!' which we have been using today, and these are available for branch members to borrow. One of them has had two 'bookings' already.
- thanked everyone who comes to the branch meetings, and hoped c. Ringing Master – that everyone continued to find them beneficial. He always attempts to cater for everyone present and today ringing had ranged from Rounds and Call-changes to London Surprise Minor.

7. Safeguarding

said that all towers should have received a notice about the most recent safeguarding guidelines. In particular:-

- a. Every tower should have a new notice "Good Practice for maintaining a safe environment in the belfry for young people" on their noticeboard (and get rid of the old one).
- b. At towers where there are children in the band, tower captains and deputy tower captains must attend a C2 safeguarding course. (Prior to this you need to have done the C1 course which can be online or classroom based). We have arranged to have a C2 safeguarding course within the branch on the morning of Saturday 31st October, and I hope to have representatives from all towers there. Please let me know if you will be there.

It is also good practice to make yourselves known to the Parish Safeguarding Officer.

c. There is an online course C0, which all ringers are advised to do.
